WHAT TO DO WHEN YOU GET A STATEMENT OF CLAIM

The person called the plaintiff has a claim against you and wants the Court to decide it.

You can:

File a notice of defence.

You must fill out the form headed "NOTICE OF DEFENCE" that came with this claim explaining why you are not responsible for part or all of the amount the plaintiff claims. This form should be filed with a Registrar at the Court and a copy served on the plaintiff.

2. Pay the amount of the claim and the plaintiff's legal costs.

If you intend to do this you should contact the plaintiff or the plaintiff's legal practitioner immediately and make arrangements to pay. Make sure you get any agreements in writing.

3. File an application for an instalment order.

If you admit you owe the amount claimed but cannot pay it all at once you may apply to the Court for an instalment order. Forms for this are available from the Court office. You must file the original with the Court and serve a copy on the plaintiff. If you make an offer to pay the money owing, you need to attach a Declaration of Financial Circumstances (Form 47C). These are obtainable from any Court Registry. It is important that you fill the form out completely and attach it to your offer to pay. If the form is not attached, the Registrar will NOT make an instalment order.

Warning: DO NOT IGNORE THIS FORM OR A JUDGMENT MAY BE MADE AGAINST YOU FOR THE WHOLE AMOUNT OF THE CLAIM AND ADDITIONAL LEGAL COSTS.
